Your Personal Data and EHFSA

Your confidentiality is protected by the Data Protection Act and, from 25 May 2018, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) (Regulation (EU) 2016/679) and the Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations 2016 (PECR). Any personal information supplied by you to EHFSA will be kept on file. We will always store these personal details securely and delete them once they are no longer relevant with the exception of consent removals. A skeletonised record of tutors' and supporters' name and addresses will be kept for historical purposes.

Members

When you join EHFSA you are asked to provide it with some Personal Data. We will also ask you to consent to which ways you wish EHFSA to communicate with you. You can opt out of any/all of our communications at any time by contacting the EHFSA secretary, Mary Skinner skinnermary18@yahoo.com. We will use the data to contact you with information and will communicate with you in the way(s) you have agreed to. The data we hold will be used to communicate with tutors, advise of any relevant events and for AGM information.

EHFSA will only allow your information to be used by other tutors and will only share them if required to do so by law. We will never share your information with other companies or charities for marketing purposes.

We do not use cookies on our website. When you visit our website, we do collect certain information that does not identify you personally, but provides us with "usage data" such as the number of visitors we receive or what pages are visited most often. This data helps us to analyse and improve the usefulness of the information we provide on our website.
